AWARD OF PhD. GRANTS

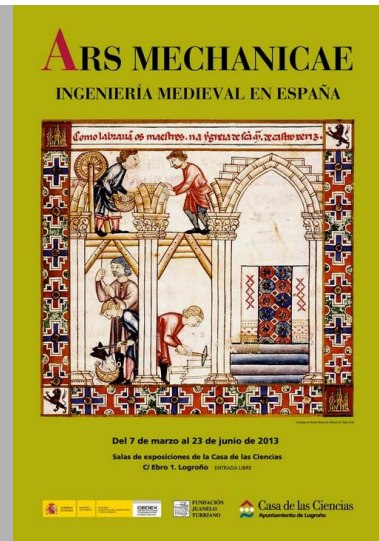


The jury for the Fundación Juanelo Turriano grants has announced their award in this edition to the following beneficiaries:
