OPENING OF THE ARTIFEX EXHIBITION IN GRAN CANARIA



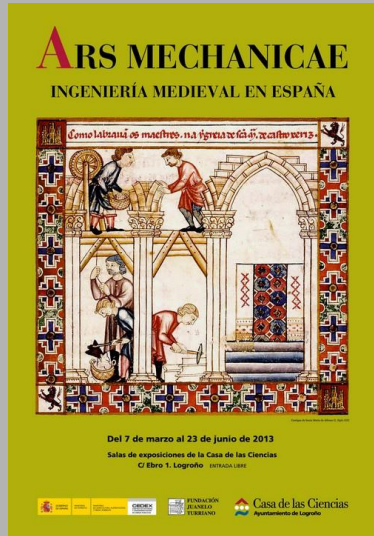

The exhibition “*Ars Mechanicae, Medieval engineering in Spain*” will be open from 7 March through 23 June at Logroño's Science Museum.

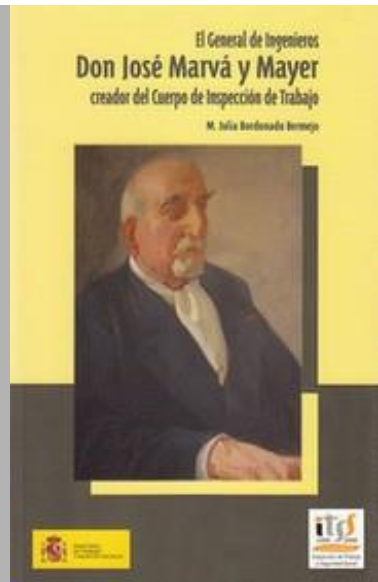

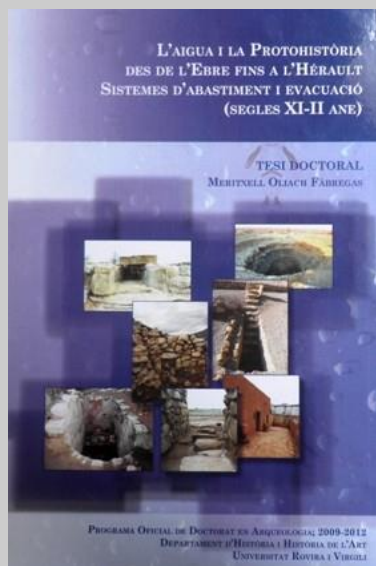
CATALONIA'S PUBLIC WORKS PLAN, 1935

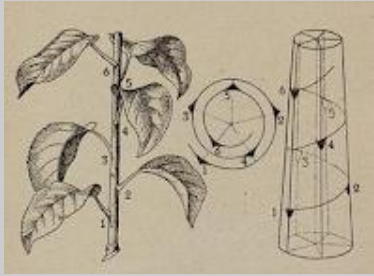
WATER AND PROTOHISTORY FROM THE EBRO TO HÉRAULT
