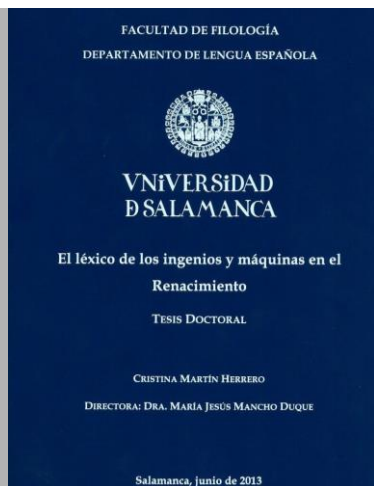
NAVY CROSS OF HONOUR AWARDED TO VICTORIANO MUÑOZ CAVA



Spanish Minister of Defence Pedro Morenés has awarded the Navy Cross of Honour to [Fundación Juanelo Turriano](#) President Victoriano Muñoz Cava, in recognition of his outstanding achievement in connection with the rehabilitation of the Peral submarine, launched in 1888, and its relocation in the Cartagena Navy Museum.
