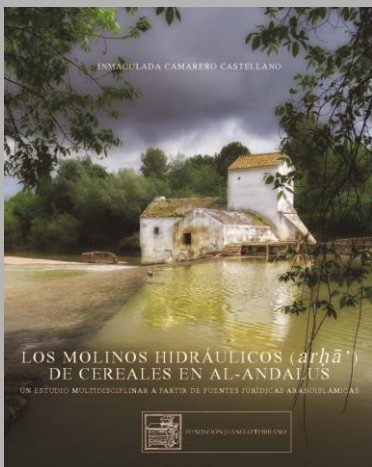
SUMMER COURSE “WATER, RIVER, CITY”: ADJOURNMENT

A total of 32 students attended the course, whose director, Pedro Navascués, is a School emeritus professor and Foundation trustee.

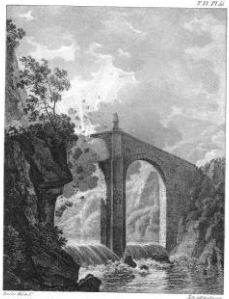
