CONFERENCES COMMEMORATING THE FOUNDATION OF THE CENTRE FOR HYDROGRAPHIC STUDIES (1933-2013)



This year marks the eightieth anniversary of the foundation of the <u>Centre for Hydrographic Studies</u>. For the occasion, the <u>Centre for Public Works Studies and Experimentation (CEDEX)</u>, with which the Centre for Hydrographic Studies became affiliated in 1960, has organised a commemorative conference series for the months of October and November. The cost-free conferences, which are open to the public, will be held in the Centre for Hydrographic Studies auditorium (P° Bajo de la Virgen del Puerto, Madrid).

CEDEX Director Mariano Navas opened the series and subsequently introduced Fernando Sáenz Ridruejo, who delivered a conference on the first stage in the history of the Centre for Hydrographic Studies, from its foundation in 1933 to its closure in 1936.
